## Gender

4,985 respondents, 17 missing
1 in 2 respondents identified their gender as "femme" or on the feminine spectrum. Just over 1 in 10 respondents selected 'other' to describe their gender.

## 3

Age
5002 respondents, 0 missing. Just over 4 in 10 ( 43 percent) respondents are under 40. Just under $\mathbf{1}$ in $\mathbf{5}$ (18 percent) are eligible for Medicare ( 65 and over): 153 respondents were born before the end of WWII (75 plus)


## 4

Region
4,817 respondents, 185 missing Every state has at least one respondent (based on zip code). The east and west coasts have the most respondents ( 28 percent each); with the least from the South ( 25 percent)

## 5

Family Class
4,979 respondents, 23 missing Just over half of all respondents said they came from a "middle class" family. Close to $\mathbf{1}$ in $\mathbf{3}$ (29 percent) in "working class", just over 1 in 10 in "upper class" and around $\mathbf{1}$ in $\mathbf{2 0}$ in "low income" families.
